EMT Training Tuition Reimbursement Policy

Adopted: August 15, 2018

For individuals interested in completing the EMT Training Program through an accredited Technical College (for example – Western, Southwest or Madison) in order to work for the Hillsboro Area Ambulance Service the following fee reimbursement schedule is in effect:

- 1. The trainee must:
 - a. Complete the application requirements of an accredited Technical College.
 - b. Be accepted into the EMT Training Program
- 2. The Hillsboro Area Ambulance Service will reimburse 50% of the application fees, tuition, book and exam fees paid to the Technical College and required immunization costs when the trainee obtains their EMT license. The remaining 50% will be reimbursed upon completion of 6 months of active service once the license is obtained. Active status will be verified by the service director(s) and at the director(s) discretion.
- 3. The 6 months of active service maybe waived if the individual has been an active EMR with the Hillsboro Ambulance Service.
- 4. Receipts for all fees and costs must be submitted to the Hillsboro Area Ambulance Service bookkeeper.
